Hooked on Gaultois

The arts and craft of Newfoundland are well-known. In particular, the tradition of hooked mats (rug hooking) is a unique craft that anyone can do.





DESCRIPTION

- Join Cathy Simms to learn how to rug hook using Briggs & Little wool yarns, locally made hooks, and patterns from Gaultois sketched by a local artist.
- Choose from several local patterns that are unique to the area, and enjoy a short studio lesson on making mats.
- You can finish the mat before you leave, or take it with you, as a kit to finish when you head home. All kits come complete with hook, pattern and all the yarn you'll need to finish the mat. It's a memory keeper!


